Who is eligible?

Anyone diagnosed with a blood cancer or a blood related disorder and their carer are eligible to use the transport service for travel to and from treatment and hospital appointments.

- All passengers need to be able to enter and leave the vehicle unaided
- Drivers are not permitted to do any manual handling
- If a booking is to include children, please discuss this with us. We are equipped with child safety seats
- Children under 18 must travel accompanied by an adult responsible for their care

Bookings are essential

Passengers must be pre-approved prior to booking.
